By careful selection of grapes together with modern technology and slow maturation afterwards in their cellars, Laurent Perrier Brut offers consistently good quality. 2	Laurent Perrier Brut Rosé Reserve Tours-Sur-Marne - France <i>Salmon-pink in colour. Precise and very crisp with a lasting impression of freshness, it has hints of soft red fruits, such as strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and black cherries on the nose. Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. 3	Laurent Perrier Ultra Brut Tours-Sur-Marne - France <i>Extra dry Champagne from the excellent Laurent-Perrier. This brilliant and delicious 'ultra' dry champagne is referred to as 'zero dosage' meaning there has been no addition of sugar to the wine after fermentation, which is the 'normal' Champagne procedure. A crisp and dry Champagne that goes particularly well with oysters or caviar.</i>	Brut NV	£49.95
4	Laurent Perrier Demi Sec Tours-Sur-Marne - France <i>The second fermentation on its lees lasts at least three years. The dosage used is a liqueur made from sugar and wine from the same batch. Roughly 45 grams of this liqueur per litre are required. Its bright, shining colour is a fairly deep golden hue. Its nose is intense, with a range of aromas, such as dried fruit, almonds and hazelnuts, with grilled and toasted hints. After a little aging, these will evolve to even deeper aromas of honey and pine resin. The richness of the Demi-Sec naturally calls for sweet dessert dishes, such as pastries or chocolate, enhancing them with considerable depth.</i>	NV	£49.95
