Energy efficiency is an integral part of our Green Strategy. The Green meeting has taken a lead role in reducing overall environmental impact through energy efficiency and other initiatives.

- We are continuing with our ambitious plan to reduce both our energy consumption and our carbon footprint by reducing our usage by a further 21,000 KWH in 2020.
- We are looking at alternative methods of energy creation, including solar wind turbine, ground source heat, biomass and battery storage.
- We have started upgrading our lighting to the latest energy-efficient LED styles.
- We have amended our purchasing policy to ensure energy ratings are considered as part of the purchasing decision for all new heavy equipment.

Our policy is to control energy usage in order to:

- Minimise energy consumption
- Maximise the use of Green Energy sources
- Reduce the environmental impact of our business.

The Management objectives are:

- Invest in energy saving measures that will offer the smallest life-cycle energy impact and best returns on investment.
- To achieve our environmental objectives, we will remain committed to the Green Meetings and our energy and environmental objectives.
- Secure the input and assistance of colleagues at all levels in order to initiate and support environmental initiatives.
- Increase customer awareness of our energy policy.
